Dear Awana Parents.

We are honored to be a part of the spiritual growth of your children, helping them to have a greater understanding of and closer relationship with Jesus Christ. Here are a few details about our Awana program:

• For club year 2024-2025 at AGC our **registration fee is \$75** for each child. This fee covers just the real cost of materials for your clubber plus shipping (handbook, uniform, bag, patches, awards) as well as the traditional "weekly \$1 dues" that supports the administration of our program. If your clubber loses or breaks an item please be prepared to cover the additional cost to replace the item.

The Awana store is supported only through special donations. Your donation may be made online at the time of clubber registration or through a designated financial gift through our church website. Choose the "Children's Ministry" fund and "Awana Club" sub-fund. Thank you! www.anchoragegrace.org/give/

- We meet each Wednesday evening during the school year. Our opening with worship music, pledges and club songs begins promptly at 6:15pm in the Chapel. Each Awana club night, the parent/guardian must check-in the child at the check-in table. Clubbers should NOT sign themselves in.
- For pick-up time: Cubbies need to be picked up at 7:45pm from the Chapel. Sparks and T&T need to be picked up at 8:00pm from their assigned meetings rooms. Please sign-out your clubbers.
- Each child will receive one-on-one assistance from a leader to recite their verses that they have been working on throughout the week with you.

- There are a variety of patches and awards that your child can earn. Ask the director of your child's group for information on how to help your child achieve awards. Sparks and T&T will also have the extra incentive to earn Awana Bucks, which they can save and spend in the Awana store.
- Awana is designed to best serve your children when home and church are working together. <u>Please look through your child's Awana handbook each week and work with them on memorizing their verses!</u>
 Discussing the meaning of the words together is a great way to help your child cement them into memory. Ask your child's leader if you have any questions about what verse(s) you should be helping them with that week.
- Once or twice a month we will be holding special theme nights and your child may have unique chances to earn more Awana bucks! Follow our calendar to always know what's coming up!
- Our Awana ministry is a team effort comprised of volunteers from several different local church families but all are in agreement to teach and lead according to the statement of faith of Anchorage Grace Church. See: anchoragegrace.org/about/what-we-believe/

Also, due to our current cultural climate, we find it important to state that our leaders will, if and when the subject arises, teach and encourage children to joyfully embrace the way that God physically created them, either male or female. God does not make mistakes.
